Terms and Conditions

- 1. Work must be submitted without author names on the submission so judging can happen anonymously. Submission can only be through the portal so the attached submission is linked to the correct author(s).
- 2. Must be free to be published.
- 3. Authors remain owners of the intellectual property of the research and Endangered Heritage will not make any commercial gain from the research without express permission by the author or all authors.
- 4. Does not have to be under the auspices of an institute or school, private conservators can submit.
- 5. Must be New Research can not be verification/replication of older research and must have proper attribution to any previous research.
- 6. Statement of originality and authorship must be completed. Submissions lacking this will not be considered.
- 7. Shared authorship must be signed by all authors for publication consent.
- 8. Submission deadline will not be altered. Late submissions will not be considered.
- Endangered Heritage will endeavour to promote "The David Hallam Conservation Research Prize" and its values and the winning participants as widely as possible to advance the public awareness of conservation and the research and work conservators carry out.
- 10. Endangered Heritage will publish the research online for the 2020 submissions. Award night is likely to be suspended in 2020 due to Covid 19 restrictions.
- 11. Staff and family of staff of Endangered Heritage will not be allowed to submit research.
- 12. All authors are encouraged to make any datasets available through a recognised data repository that can create a persistent digital identifier, preferably a digital object identifier (DOI).
- 13. If there is a DOI or other persistent digital identifier for the data in the submission, please include this information within your submission.
